**REGULATION NO. 2007/33**

**ON THE PROMULGATION OF  
THE LAW ON ROAD TRAFFIC SAFETY  
ADOPTED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF KOSOVO**

The Special Representative of the Secretary-General,

Pursuant to the authority given to him under United Nations Security Council resolution 1244 (1999) of 10 June 1999,

In conformity with sections 9.1.44 and 9.1.45 of the Constitutional Framework for Provisional Self-Government in Kosovo (UNMIK Regulation No. 2001/9 of 15 May 2001),

Taking into account a communication from the President of the Assembly of Kosovo dated 3 December 2007, concerning the Law on Road Traffic Safety adopted by the Assembly of Kosovo on 11 January 2007,

Noting that the provisions of the Law shall be without prejudice to the authority of the Special Representative of the Secretary-General under UNSCR 1244 (1999) or his reserved powers and responsibilities under the Constitutional Framework for Provisional Self-Government in Kosovo,

Hereby promulgates, effective as of the date of signature, the Law on Road Traffic Safety adopted by the Assembly of Kosovo (Law No. 02/L-70) attached to the present Regulation, provided that:

A.

- (a) The term “neighboring countries”, in Articles 3.1 7), shall be replaced by “areas outside Kosovo”;
- (b) The term “citizen(s)” in Articles 3.1. 10) and 281.1 shall be replaced by “resident(s)”.

- (c) Article 12.2 shall be revised to read: “Prior of commencing works foreseen in paragraph 1 of the present Article (except in emergency cases) a person must have been granted permission by competent organs depending on the road type and inform the Police regarding this.”
- (d) Article 4.3 shall be revised to read: “In areas where KFOR or KPC units are situated, supervision during the movement of these units may also be carried out by authorized personnel of such units in public traffic.”
- (e) The term “minor offence” shall be replaced by “violation of this provision” throughout the Law.
- (f) The term “citizen” in Article 102.2 shall be deleted.
- (g) Article 121 shall be revised to read:
  - “121.1. Motor vehicles as a general rule use the dim lights.
  - 121.2. The use of full beam is exceptionally allowed unless
    - a) another vehicle approaches;
    - b) when no other car is in front which would be disturbed by the full beam;
    - c) if the vehicle is operated near to a railway or sailing boat so that a train or a boat might be disturbed;
    - d) a pedestrian column is in sight.
  - 121.3. A violation of this provision will be fined with at least 35 Euro.”
- (h) The term “the other country” in Article 225.1 shall be replaced by “a foreign country”.
- (i) Article 304.2 shall be deleted.
- (j) In Article 305.4 the words “and the KS sign from Article 304” shall be deleted.
- (k) The term “Kosovë” in Article 376 shall be replaced by “Kosovo”.

B.

The provisions of Executive Decision No. 2003/13 on the Registration of Privately Operated Vehicles in Kosovo by Habitual Residents of Kosovo of 30 August 2003 will remain in force.

These changes shall be reflected in the final official text of the Law.
