**REGULATION NO. 2006/57**

**ON THE PROMULGATION  
OF THE LAW ON FIRE PROTECTION  
ADOPTED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF KOSOVO**

The Acting Special Representative of the Secretary-General,

Pursuant to the authority given to him under United Nations Security Council resolution 1244 (1999) of 10 June 1999,

In conformity with Chapter 5.1 (i) and (m), 5.5 (b) and section 9.1.26 (a) of the Constitutional Framework for Provisional Self-Government in Kosovo (UNMIK Regulation No. 2001/9 of May 2001),

Taking into account the communication from the President of the Assembly of Kosovo dated 18 April 2006 concerning the Law on Fire Protection adopted by the Assembly of Kosovo on 6 April 2006,

Noting that the provisions of the Law shall be without prejudice to the authority of the Special Representative of the Secretary-General under UNSCR 1244 (1999) or his reserved powers and responsibilities under the Constitutional Framework for Provisional Self-Government in Kosovo,

Hereby promulgates, effective as of the date of signature, the Law on Fire Protection adopted by the Assembly of Kosovo (Law No. 02/L-41) attached to the present Regulation, provided that: the word "offence" where ever it appears in Chapter 10 shall be replaced by the word "violation"; and in Article 55 the words "or imprisonment" and "minor" shall be deleted.

These changes shall be reflected in the final official text of the Law.
