

**REGULATION NO. 2007/4**

**ON THE PROMULGATION OF THE LAW  
FOR PROTECTION AGAINST NATURAL AND OTHER DISASTERS  
ADOPTED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF KOSOVO**

The Special Representative of the Secretary General,

Pursuant to the authority given to him under United Nations Security Council resolution (UNSCR) 1244 (1999) of 10 June 1999,

In conformity with Chapter 8.1 and sections 9.1.44 and 9.1.45 of the Constitutional Framework for Provisional Self-Government in Kosovo (UNMIK Regulation No. 2001/9 of 15 May 2001),

Taking into account a communication from the President of the Assembly of Kosovo, dated 21 June 2006, concerning the Law for Protection Against Natural and Other Disasters adopted by the Assembly of Kosovo on 1 June 2006,

Noting that the provisions of the Law shall be without prejudice to the authority of the Special Representative of the Secretary-General under UNSCR 1244 (1999) or his reserved powers and responsibilities under the Constitutional Framework for Provisional Self-Government in Kosovo,

Hereby promulgates, effective as of the date of signature, the Law for Protection Against Natural and Other Disasters adopted by the Assembly of Kosovo (Law No. 02/L-68) attached to the present Regulation, provided that:

(a) Provisions in paragraphs (v) and (vii) of Article 25 and (iv), (v) and (vi) of Article 53 shall be implemented in full conformity with Chapter 8 of the Constitutional Framework for Provisional Self-Government in Kosovo;

(b) In Chapter XV, the word “offence” will be replaced wherever it appears by “violation”.

The changes above shall be reflected in the final official text of the Law.
